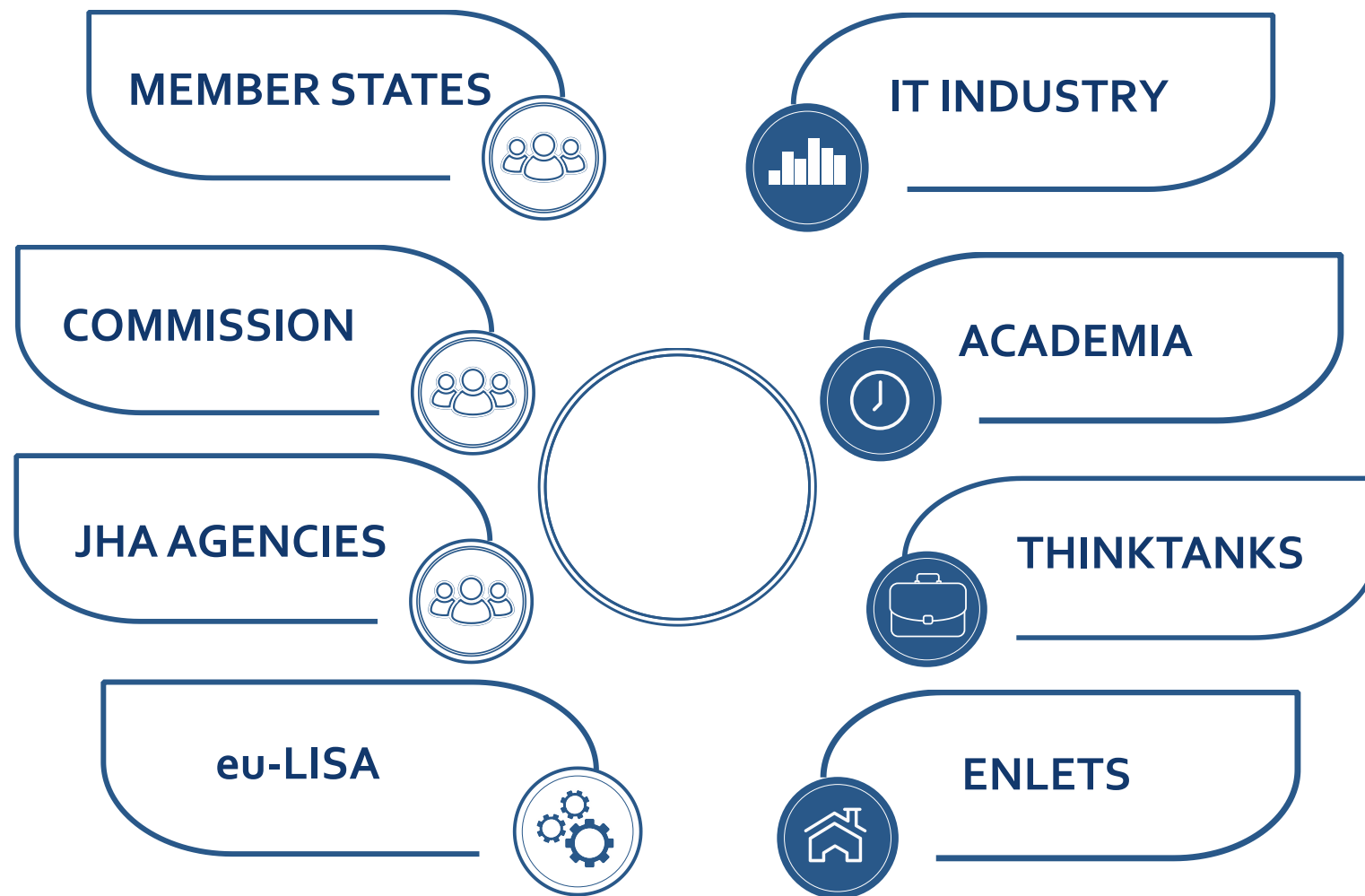

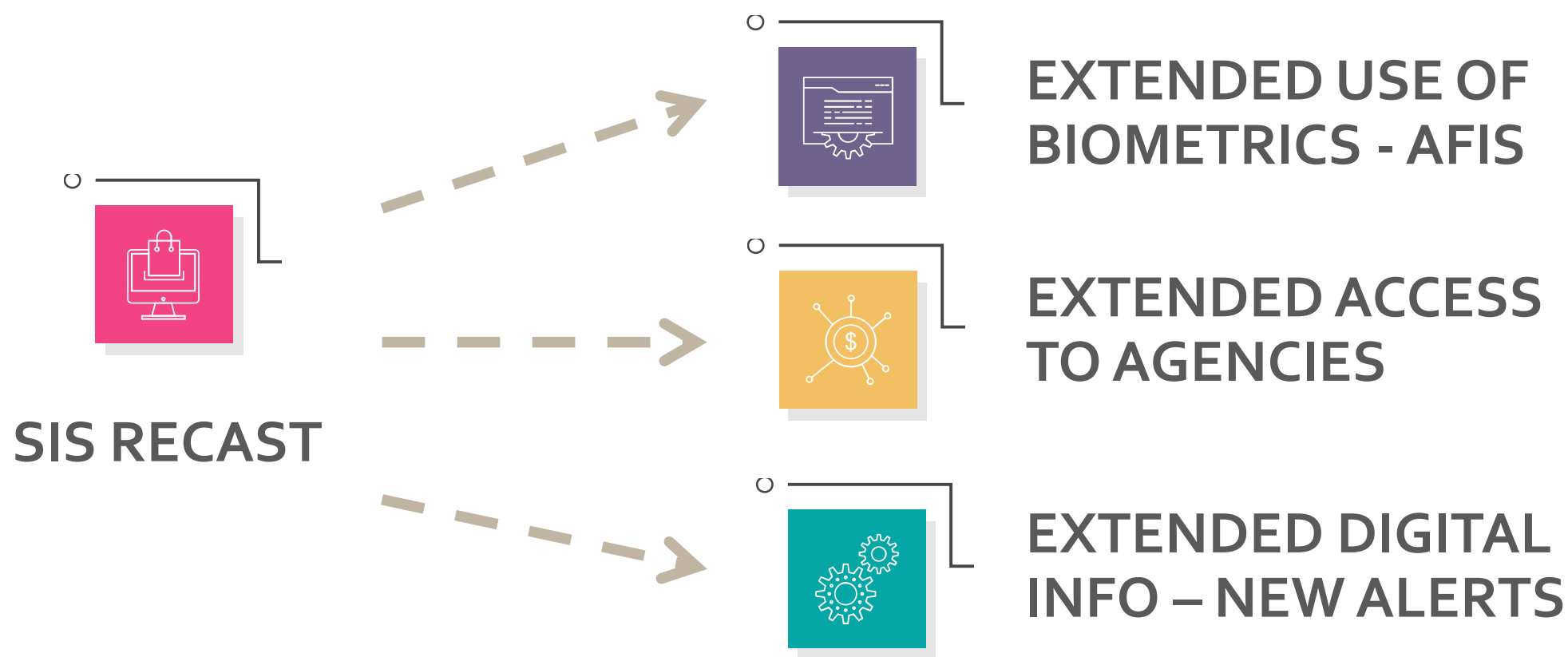

BIOMETRIC CHECKS (sBMS, MID) allow identification without ID-docs

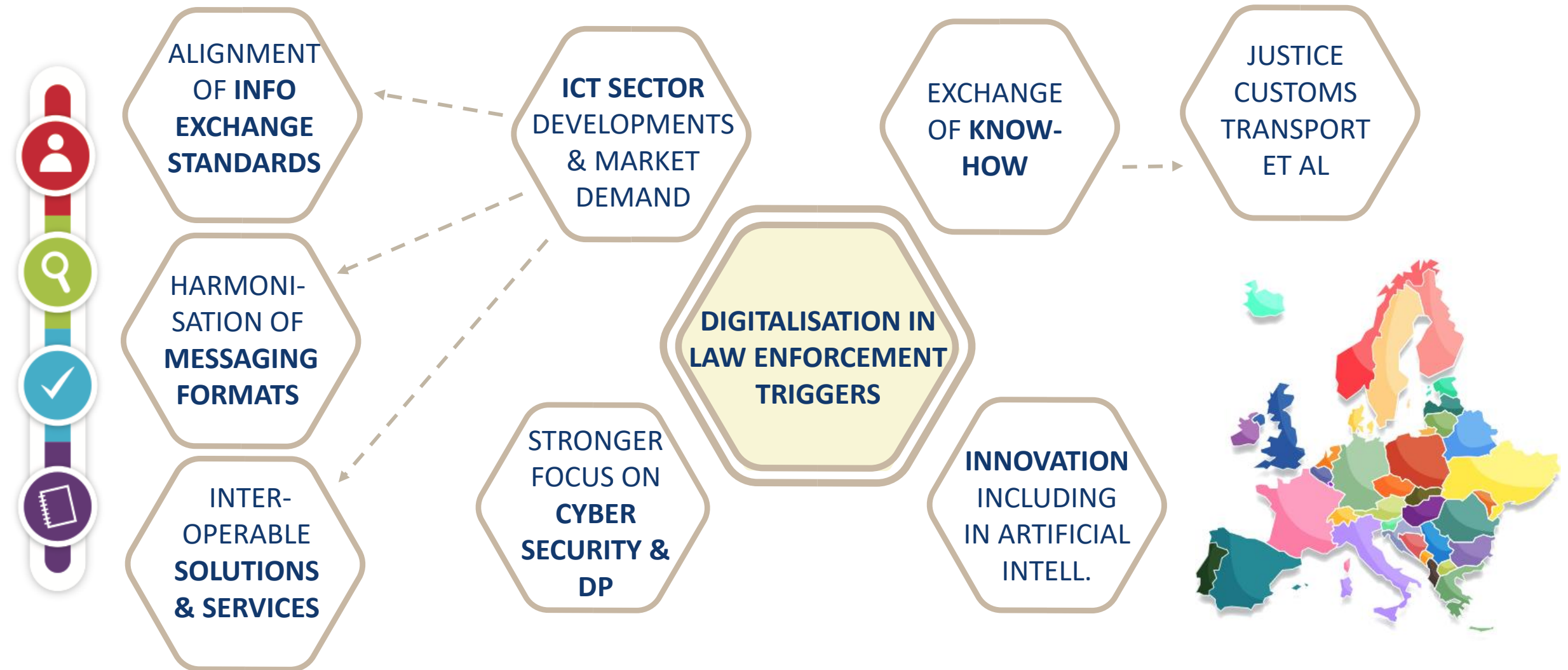


TRANSVERSAL SERVICES to replace the silo approach
